· Upon Motion of Counsel for the Chancery Lane Dublin Real Estate SÁRL (the "Company") pursuant to Notice of Motion filed on the 6th of May 2026 for following reliefs

- 1. An order pursuant to Order 63A, Rule 4 of the Rules of the Superior Courts 1986 (as amended) directing that the within proceedings be entered into the Commercial List of the High Court on the grounds that these proceedings constitute commercial proceedings within the meaning of Order 63A, Rule 1(b) of the Rules of the Superior Courts (as amended).*
- 2. An order treating the hearing of the within application for entry into the Commercial List as the initial directions hearing in respect of the*

originating notice of motion herein (the Originating Notice) and in that regard:

- 2.1 If the Court deems it appropriate, an order pursuant to Regulation 20(1)(a) of the European Union (Cross-Border Conversions, Mergers and Divisions) Regulations 2023 (the “2023 Regulations”) approving the cross-border conversion of the Company pursuant to Draft Terms of Cross-Border Conversion drawn up by the Board of Directors of the Company on 19 December 2025 (the Conversion) (the Court having examined the legality of the conversion as regards the procedure which concerns the completion thereof, including the proposed formation of an Irish converted company, and having been satisfied that the requirements of Regulation 20(3) have been met).*
- 2.2 An order pursuant to Regulation 20(6) of the 2023 Regulations specifying the date on which the conversion is to have effect.*
- 2.3 An order directing such officer of the Court, as the Court may nominate, to deliver a certified copy of the Court’s order under Regulation 20(1)(a) to the Registrar of Companies.*
- 2.4 In the alternative to the orders sought above in paragraphs 2 to 2.2, an order fixing the time and date of the hearing (the Hearing Date) of the Company’s application pursuant to Regulation 20 of the 2023*

Regulations for the reliefs set out above at paragraphs 2 to 2.2.

2.5 To the extent the Court sets such a Hearing Date, and to the extent necessary, an order

- a. prescribing the procedure to be followed by any party who is entitled to appear and wishes to be heard on the Hearing Date and in that regard, specifying the time within which any party wishing to appear must file or serve notice of his/her intention to appear and within which any affidavit upon which reliance is to be put by such person should be served and filed; and,*
- b. directing the advertisement of the Hearing Date, and a summary of any directions given by the Court in such publications as the Court may direct.*

3. In the alternative, an order fixing a date for the initial directions hearing in respect of the within proceedings.

4. Such further or other orders as the Court considers necessary or desirable.

5. Costs.

Whereupon on reading said Notice of Motion the Certificate of Ashling Walsh of RDJ LLP Solicitors containing the two undertakings in compliance with High Court Practice Direction HC122 filed on the 6th day of May 2026 the

grounding Affidavit of Eamon Waters filed on the 6th day of May 2026 the exhibits referred to therein and the Motion

And upon hearing said Counsel

And the Court being satisfied that these proceedings are commercial proceedings within the meaning of Order 63A Rule 1(b) of the Rules of the Superior Courts 1986 (as amended)

IT IS ORDERED that these proceedings be entered in the Commercial List for hearing and that all further applications and Motions be heard in said List

And the Court treating the hearing of this Motion as the substantive hearing

And the Court the being satisfied that the requirements of Regulation 20(3) of the 2023 Regulations have been met

THE COURT DOTH MAKE AN ORDER pursuant to Regulation 20 of the 2023 Regulations that the cross-border conversion of the Company be and is hereby approved

AND IT IS ORDERED that that the cross-border conversion shall become effective on the 1st day of June 2026 at 00.00 IST (Irish Standard Time)

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be delivered by RDJ LLP to the Registrar within 14 days in accordance with Regulation 21 of the 2023 Regulations
